<p>How will you gather information on the visitors, including at tangihanga or funerals?</p>	<p>Consider:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How are you going to collect contact tracing information: name, arrival time, departure time? Ex.: people to sign on and off on a clipboard at the waharoa • You can use this form for contact tracing
<p>How will you manage an exposure or suspected exposure to COVID-19?</p>	<p>Consider:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gathering and using contact tracing information • Clean down procedures • Contacting Healthline
<p>How will you check to see if your strategies are effective?</p>	<p>Consider:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adapting plans as you find better/easier ways to do things • How to ensure whānau members are raising concerns or solutions • How will you communicate changes
